Paspoort Perikelen

Een bijdrage van Jos Wunnik

DEN HAAG - Mensen mogen op de pasfoto's voor het nieuwe paspoort niet meer lachen. Ze moeten neutraal kijken en de mond gesloten houden. Dat staat in de aangescherpte regels voor foto's op het nieuwe elektronische paspoort.

Dit heeft een woordvoerster van het ministerie van Binnenlandse Zaken vrijdag bevestigd.

Eind augustus wordt het nieuwe reisdocument ingevoerd. Daarin komt een chip waarin behalve de persoonsgegevens ook de foto wordt opgenomen. Later komen er twee vingerafdrukken in de chip.

De foto's moeten recht van voren worden gemaakt, in kleur zijn en een neutrale lichtgrijze achtergrond hebben. Brillen mogen, maar de glazen daarvan mogen niet te veel reflecteren. Een hoofddoek mag ook, om religieuze redenen, maar het hele gezicht moet goed te zien zijn. Verder zijn er eisen gesteld aan de korrelgrootte en de grootte van de persoon op de foto. Volgens Binnenlandse Zaken gelden al regels voor de pasfoto's maar waren die tot nu toe niet zo strikt omschreven.

Afwijkende of onduidelijke foto's worden nu ook al geweerd bij de aanvraag.

Met de eerste generatie nieuwe reisdocumenten volgt Nederland Europese regels voor veiligheidskenmerken en biometrische gegevens.

CONGRESSMAN PETER HOEKSTRA (R-MI) ANNOUNCES FOUNDING OF THE DUTCH CONGRESSIONAL CAUCUS AT THE NETHERLAND-AMERICA FOUNDATION (NAF) AWARDS DINNER ON MAY 12, 2006

New York, May 12, 2006; Congressman Peter Hoekstra (R-MI), Chairman of the House Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence, announced the founding of the Congressional Caucus on the Netherlands during the annual Netherland-America Foundation (NAF) Awards Dinner on May 12, 2006 at the OAS Building in Washington, DC.

Congressman Hoekstra said the Caucus will work with the Royal Netherlands Embassy in Washington, DC and the Netherland-America Foundation to preserve and enhance the existing relationships between the United States and the Netherlands, by educating members of Congress and their staffs on the importance of these relationships between the two countries. The Caucus will pursue its mission by hosting events and briefings and by supporting events sponsored by such key partners as the Netherlands Embassy to the United States and the NAF.

Congressman Hoekstra was born in Groningen, the Netherlands, and immigrated to Holland, Michigan, with his family when he was three years old. He is the only current member of Congress born in the Netherlands. Congressman Chris Van Hollen (D-MD), who is of Dutch descent, will serve with Congressman Hoekstra as co-chairman of the Caucus. Congressman Van Hollen said, "I am pleased to work with my colleague towards the group's important mission and I look forward to deepening our nation's ties with such a critical ally."

Senator Pat Roberts (R-KS), the Chairman of the Senate Select Committee on Intelligence, the keynote speaker at the May 12 NAF Awards Dinner, will also be a member of the Caucus. The Caucus currently includes the following Members of Congress: Senator Mary Landrieu (D-LA), Rep. Leonard Boswell (D-IA), Rep. Jo Ann Davis (R-VA), Rep. Vernon Ehlers (R-MI), Rep. Jim Gerlach (R-PA), Rep. Joseph Knollenberg (R-MI), Rep. Donald A. Manzullo (R-IL), Rep. Thaddeus McCotter (R-MI), Rep. Michael McNulty (D-NY), Rep. Collin Peterson (D-MN), Rep. Ileana Ros-Lehtinen (R-FL), and Rep. Edolphus Towns (D-NY). Additional members are being added as this press release is issued.

At the NAF Awards Dinner, Congressman Hoekstra was presented with the prestigious Ambassador C. Howard Wilkins, Jr. Award for his significant contributions to the relationships between the United States and the Netherlands in the field of politics and government. Ambassador Wilkins was U.S. Ambassador to the Netherlands from 1989 to 1992.

- B. Kiezers die op 22 november 2006 (dag van stemming) wegens beroep of werkzaamheden in het buitenland verblijven;**
- C. Kiezers die op 22 november 2006 (dag van stemming) wegens beroep of werkzaamheden van hun partner of ouder in het buitenland verblijven.**

(vakantiegangers kunnen dus niet stemmen via internet of brief)

Kiezers uit categorie A (woonplaats) kunnen zich registreren als kiezer middels een D3-formulier. Dit formulier is als pdf-bestand te downloaden van www.kiezenuithetbuitenland.nl (beschikbaar vanaf 14 juli)

Het ingevulde formulier kunnen zij ondertekend en met een kopie van hun Nederlandse paspoort/identiteitskaart aan het Consulaat Generaal te Miami sturen.

De gemeente Den Haag behandelt het registratieverzoek van de internet- of briefstemmer samen met het Ministerie van BZK. De kiezers krijgen zo snel mogelijk na registratie hun stembescheiden toegestuurd.

Kiezers uit categorie B of C (beroep) kunnen een verzoek tot internetstemmen rechtstreeks indienen bij de Nederlandse gemeente waar zij ingeschreven staan middels een ander formulier (M3-formulier) dat tevens te vinden is op de website www.kiezenuithetbuitenland.nl

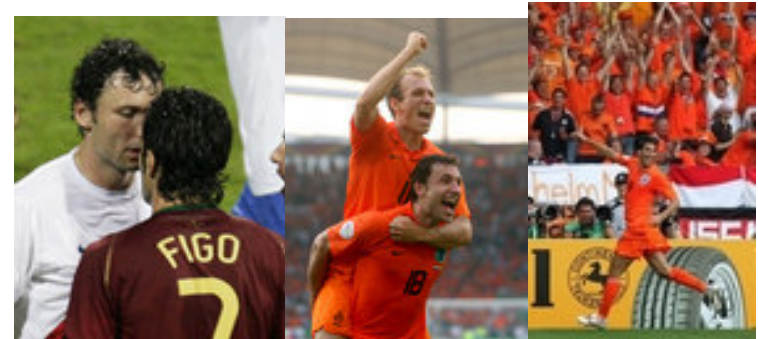

National Football Team falls to Portugal in World Cup; Italy wins



In a true “voetbalveldslag” the National Dutch Football team lost to Portugal in the World Cup in Germany over the summer in the first round of the knock-out phase. The Dutch had plenty of chances to score, but were defeated by the Portuguese 1-0. The match made history in a more dubious manner, because it poured yellow and red cards, and fair and continuous play was hard to find. Incredibly, four players (two on each side) were gone (red-carded) by the end of the match. The Portuguese seemed a bit slyer in their methods how to influence the Russian referee, and that was the difference in the match.

After the match the referee was sent home, but that was a “schrone troost” for our countrymen. Coach van Basten made a dubious decision to leave one of the most prolific goal scorers in the world (van Nistelrooy) on the bench for the whole match, and will be questioned about this for a long time to come.

In a disappointing final, Italy topped France in penalty kicks for the gold after a 1-1 tie.

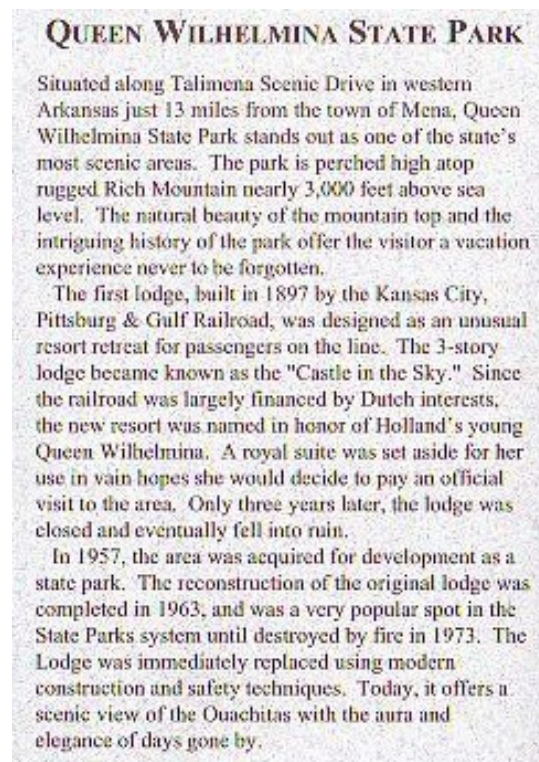

Leiden's Ontzet

Thursday, October 5, 2006 from 7 pm. onwards.

Henk's European Deli, 5811 Blackwell Street, Dallas

Leiden was besieged for nearly a year in 1574. The Dutch army, led by William of Orange (nicknamed "the Silent"), deliberately flooded the fields around Leiden, breaking the dikes, to force the Spanish armies to raise their siege. The Spanish tried to lure the citizens into surrender with promises, but the people of Leiden decided to stick it out in spite of a terrible shortage of food which brought the people on the verge of starvation. Finally the Spanish withdrew, and the siege ended on October 3, 1574. The Dutch army entered the city with food: bread with cheese and herring. The date on which the siege ended is still celebrated every year with large scale festivities, and.... with bread and herring.

As part of this Dutch tradition, Adrian and Hubert Winnubst will be serving herring, hutspot and white bread. Let us all meet at **Henk's** to celebrate **Leiden's Ontzet**. The charge for the meal will be \$16 per person.

Reservations Reminder

On several occasions the club has incurred losses due to members who had made reservations without paying, and then not showing up for the event.

When you are making a reservation for an event, we ask that you make a reservation with, and send a check to, our director Hilde Wilkinson.

It has happened that some members made reservations, without sending a check, and then don't show up.

Your Board would like to point out that as a result of reservations, commitments are being made by the Club. In other words, if you make a reservation for the Queen's Ball for two people without sending a check, and do not show up, the Club is still responsible for paying \$35 for each member who did not come (\$25 paid by member, plus \$10 additional which the Club paid for each member.) This is a loss of \$70 for your Club.

It has been decided for future events, that unless your reservation is accompanied or immediately followed by a check, no reservation will be made. In other words, if there is **NO check, there is **NO** reservation. Please ensure the timely receipt of the check; commitments will only be made based on the checks received.**

In case you have made a paid reservation and are then prevented from coming, the club will refund your money, provided the Reservations Chair receives the notification of cancellation before the commitment is made.
