Holland is, and has always been, colorblind. I have a video of Sinterklaas' arrival in Alkmaar, Holland where an estimated 1 million people of all races, white, black, brown, etc. attended and where no one took offence about the 15 Zwarte Pieten! There are simply no racial implications!

And also the Christmas Reception was again a great success. Because of construction delays at the venue where we have had the reception the last few years, we had to move the reception to a new location at a very late date. Thank you, Hans and Kay Polk, for offering the use of your brand-new flower shop, Tulipa, in Allen on such short notice. You have a beautiful and tastefully decorated facility there.

My wife, Meta and I, have been members of the Holland-America Club for many years and all events that we have attended have been successes. We have a good club here with lots of, often interesting, events. In just three months, October, November and December, we have had, in addition to the events I mentioned above, also the Leiden's Ontzet and Horseback Riding/Barbeque events. The board tries very hard to please every one!


Sinterklaas allowed the children to sit on his lap and he and his Pieten posed for many pictures.
